908 Old Westminster Pike is a transitional house between the late nineteenth and early twentieth century periods. It contains many features of the regional farmhouse including its symmetrical facade, massing and proportions. It has lost the L-wing, however, to a square-shaped plan formed under a projection of the rear of the gable roof. The house is covered in German siding and has a full-length, one-story porch. Also on the property is a mid-twentieth century, concrete block, two-bay garage.


