936 Old Westminster Pike is a regional style farmhouse with fanciful sawn-wood ornamentation. The house is a two-story, five-bay by two-bay structure with an L-shaped plan. However, its Victorian period ornamentation contains unique designs. There is a wide gabled dormer with a circular window. The bargeboard above the window has a sawn-wood circular pattern with a cross in the center, four half-circles, and scroll ornamentation. The porch brackets contain elaborate scroll patterns.




