**Description of Property and Justification:** *(Please attach map and photo)*

The Shriver Farm (CARR-804) is located at 1400 Littlestown Pike. This two-story Queen Anne style house was built c. 1900. The house features a wooden frame structural system that rests on a solid foundation of stucco clad brick. The exterior walls of the house are covered in asbestos siding, and the cross-gabled roof is clad in composition shingles. One concrete chimney is located on the northern exterior wall of the house. A wraparound porch spans the entire east and south façades. The porch is supported by turned wooden posts with simple brackets. The house also features a polygonal tower on the south elevation and decorative spindle work in the gable ends. The original windows have been replaced with one-over-one aluminum sash windows. Shed (A) and (B) are located to the southwest of the house. Shed (A) features exterior walls that are clad in vertical boards, and a gabled roof covered in standing-seam metal. Shed (B) features exterior walls and a gabled roof that are both covered in 5-V crimp metal. Each of the two sheds display one-bay on the south elevation.

This house is recommended as not eligible for the NRHP due to multiple alterations that diminish its architectural integrity. Alterations include the addition of asbestos siding, replaced windows, and the addition of new roofing materials. The Shriver Farm house has no apparent association with any event or person significant in our nation's history, lacks architectural significance, and does not appear to have the ability to yield important information.




Resource Sketch Map
