

NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC <u>No</u></p> <p>This house is attached to the gambrel roof dwelling, described in CE 101, by one corner and a common utility room which used to be an early kitchen. It is a two story frame building which is four bays long and one room deep. The two outer bays are paneled doors, which swing on their original strap hinges, and the two inner bays are windows with 6/6 shsh, which used to have shutters, as the pintels are still on the frames. Between floors is a pent eave on all exposed sides and on the gable is a pent eave which is a continuation of the cornice. On the south half of the facade is a narrow second story porch. To the southeast has been built an addition nearly the same size as the original with all trim matching the old house.</p> <p>5.
