The Reden-Purner house stands along Route 213 South of Chesapeake City and is typical of the late 19th century 2½ story three bay by one room frame houses with attached kitchen wing. DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Reden-Purner House c. 1870 is a 2½ story three bay by one room I-House with ell kitchen wing. The house is located on Maryland 213 south Chesapeake City, Md. and faces east with a north/south axis.

The front block rests on a full concrete basement that was dug long after the construction of the house. The original foundation was laid with fieldstone. The frame house is covered with asbestos shingle over weatherboard siding. The composition tile roof is steeply pitched with a central cross gable.

The east (main) facade is three bay across with a central entrance and corresponding 2/2 sash windows. The surrounds have a late 19th century molding. The central cross gable is lighted by a pointed 2/2 sash. A single gabled porch covers the central bay. The supports are turned.

The north and south gable ends are basically similar with single 2/2 sash on each floor. The eaves are extended and the soffits sloped on the main facade. A central stuccoed brick stove rises out of the center of the house.

A shorter two story kitchen ell primarily covers the west side and is detailed similarly to the main block. A shed porch is attached to the south side of the wing.

The first floor plan of the front block consists of an enclosed central stair with a room on each side. Late 19th century trim has been generally removed and finishes redone.
