C. 1830-1850

Standing within a few hundred yards of the Delaware-Maryland line is this two story side hall/double parlor Flemish bond brick farmhouse. The tract of land is a small part of the sprawling "Welsh Tract" which Andrew McIntire Sr. bequeathed to his son Andrew McIntire, Jr. in Nov. of 1850. (B 9/485) The main house extends to the west with a shorter two story three bay kitchen wing with unusual single story brick outshut that was used as a wash^{house}house. The outshut is incorporated into a single story shed roof porch on the south side of the wing which has a brick paving below. Single story shed roof porches are also attached to the north and south sides of the main house but differ in material. They both date from the mid to late 19th century but, while the north facade porch is executed in wood, the porch on the south side is graced with decorative iron.
