Due to heavy foliage only half of this five bay mansard roof house is visible. Behind the dogwood and evergreen is a two story three sided bay window. The bracketed cornice follows the protruding outline the bay window creates. The L shaped frame house is two rooms deep on the north end but only one room deep on the south side. The three rooms are divided by a central passage. A two story kitchen wing addition extends the house due west.

Mathew M. Naudain, farmer, owned this house along with 110 acres. He is listed on the atlas patron list as having a Delaware Family History.


