Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

Antego is a two-story, three bay, frame dwelling clad in wood clapboard with an asphalt shingled roof that dates from the mid-nineteenth century. There is a full-length shed-roofed porch on the front façade and paired brick interior gable end chimneys. The windows are 6/6 wood sash with metal storm windows and vinyl faux shutters. There is a two-story cross-gabled section and a one-story shed-roofed section to the rear that are contemporaneous with the primary structure. There is a large two-story addition and a one-story two-car garage addition to the rear of the house dating from post-1980.

Outbuildings on the property include a mid-to late nineteenth century stone and frame bank barn, a late nineteenth to early twentieth century shed along Deaver Road, and a modern (post-1960) shed roofed structure previously used as a hen house and dog house. There are also ruins of a stone foundation adjacent to the late nineteenth to early twentieth century shed on Deaver Road.

According to historic maps, in the mid- to late nineteenth century Judge James McCauley of Leeds owned Antego. McCauley also owned a house in Leeds, which is marked as his primary residence on historic maps (Martenet 1858; Lake, Griffing, and Stevenson 1877). McCauley was an active and prominent local politician. Offices he held in Cecil County included County Surveyor, Register of Wills, representative to the Maryland House of Delegates, School Commissioner and President of the

School Board, and Chief Justice of the Cecil County Orphan's Court from 1868 until 1895 (Chapman 1897:409-410). McCauley died in 1897.

The property was added to the Maryland Inventory of Historic Properties in 1981. At the time of the previous survey, the house retained most of its original decorative features, such as a hipped roof porch, slate roof, and bargeboard trim. Since 1981, the house has been significantly altered and no longer retains sufficient integrity of design, materials, workmanship, and feeling necessary for listing on the National Register of Historic Places. The bargeboard trim has been stripped from the house, the porch has been removed and replaced with one of different size and shape, and the exterior sheathing of the house has been replaced with modern materials. A large addition has been added to the back of the building more than doubling its size and altering the historic footprint. According to the property owner, the house is an advanced state of decay from rot and/or termite damage and is slated for demolition.




