Distinctly separate methods of construction, architectural periods, and structural placement distinguish the two sections of this fieldstone and frame house on Little Egypt Road. The early 19th century two story one room plan fieldstone house is built into a bank and faces northern fields. This orientation changed with the construction of a perpendicularly placed frame addition. The frame gable end addition faced the road instead of the surrounding fields and was fitted with popularly decorative "fishscale" shingles on each gable along with a shed roof front porch.
