Addendum

The Strahorn Property is located at 4647 Telegraph Road, Maryland route 273, which bisects the Fair Hill N.R.M.A. in Cecil County. It is situated not far from the Fair Hill Race Track and is now being restored by the Doto Family under the Maryland Department of Natural Resources Curatorship Program. This property includes a farmhouse, a bank barn, two sheds, a concrete block house, as well as, a temporary housing structure.

The farmhouse is two and one-half stories tall, three-bays long by two-bays wide, and in a "T"-shaped design. It dates from the late Nineteenth century and has Italianate and Gothic Revival elements present in it's construction. On the east side facade there is a one story addition with a second story walk out porch. The frame construction of the house rests on a foundation of uncut fieldstone. The exterior is entirely clad in simple, dropped, horizontal clapboard. A centered gabled roof on the north facade is covered with replacement composition shingles, which were originally wood shingles. The eaves are open with exposed rafters and dominate the roof structure. On either side of the centered gable are interior capped chimneys, as well as, an interior capped chimney on the rear, south, facade. The window and door trim on the first two floors is pedimented in an Italianate style, however the windows in the attic gables have a pointed arch in a Gothic Revival style. The sashes in all windows are 2/2. The interior of the farmhouse is in the process of being renovated back to it's original condition, but still has many elements of the original fabric.

The bank barn is typical of others in the Fair Hill area with it's stone foundation, vertical wood siding, and metal seam roof. Notable features of the barn are an addition that extends out from the front (north) facade, as well as, a side (east) addition that has a wooden arched entryway. The bottom portion of the barn is completely open, exposing the stone foundation, and leading to a fenced in barnyard.

The storage shed, concrete block house, and temporary house are all recent additions to the property, and therefore not historic. They are being used while the Dotos restore the farmhouse.

The condition of the property is excellent with the Curators providing meticulous maintenance and restoration of the structures.


