C. 1871

The inscription "Moore's Chapel, Methodist Protestant Church - 1871" firmly establishes the date of construction and grantor of this Fourth District church property. Gabriel and Sarah Moore granted to the trustees of Methodist Protestant Church at Fairview a parcel of land containing three roods and thirty square perches for a "comfortable house of public worship for their neighborhood with a suitable burying ground."

I his Deed made this twenty fourth day of April in the year
 eighteen hundred and sixty nine by us Gabriel Moore and
 Sarah Moore his wife of Cecil County and State of Maryland
 Witnesses that in consideration of their earnest desire to
 assist in furnishing a comfortable house of public worship
 for their neighborhood, with a suitable burying ground
 attached, we the said Gabriel Moore and Sarah Moore his wife
 do grant unto William Chidester, Gabriel M. Sanderling Gabriel
 Moore, Reuben Griffith, John McAlister, Thomas Moore John
 Guter and their successors, Trustees in trust for the use of the
 Methodist Protestant Church at Fair View in the fourth elec-
 tion District of Cecil County aforesaid, all that lot or
 parcel of land situate at or near Fair View aforesaid
 beginning for the same on the south side of the public
 road from Lombardville to Lewisville, being a corner of
 the lands of Gabriel Moore and Reuben Griffith and running
 west along the south side of said road four perches
 to a stone, thence South one and a half degrees, East
 thirty seven and a half perches to Charles Wadsworths
 land, thence with the same, East four perches to a stone a
 corner of Reuben Griffiths land, thence with the same by a
 straight line to the place of beginning, containing
 three rods and thirty square perches of land more or less
 issuing out of said lot of ground a burial lot eight
 feet by twenty feet in such part thereof as the said Gabriel
 Moore may choose. To have and to hold the within described
 lot or parcel of land unto the said Trustees duly incorporated
 for the use of the Methodist Protestant Church at Fair View
 aforesaid, and their successors forever subject nevertheless
 to this stipulation and agreement, that if a church is not
 built on the lot herein described for the period of three full
 years from this date, then this grant shall cease, and the said
 lot of land shall revert to the said Gabriel Moore his heirs
 or assigns
