DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Pearson-Orr Farm c. 1840-1850 is a three story four bay by one room stuccoed fieldstone house on Post Road a mile SW of Route 274. The house faces west with the main gable running north/south.

The house rests on a partial fieldstone foundation and is covered with a medium pitched composition tile roof with boxed cornice and beaded bargeboard.

The first floor of the main elevation is covered by a shed roof enclosed porch. It undoubtedly was open at one time since the gable ends are sheathed with vertical strips with a mouse-tooth bottom edge. The sides are covered with aluminum siding. The placement of the front door was not visible. The second floor is lighted by four 6/6 sash windows with a small corner bead on the surround, the third floor has four 3/3 sash directly above the other openings.

The north and south gable end have a single 6/6 sash on each floor and a 3/3 attic window that flank the interior end chimneys.

The east side is primarily covered by a two story two bay by one room frame kitchen wing with a single story shed fill in the NE corner. The back of the main block only has three openings on each floor. The interior was not open at the time of survey.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The three story form with smaller third floor windows is a direct carryover from the three story Federal buildings that were popular three or four decades earlier. The interior styling of this type of house usually dates from the third or fourth decade of the 19th century.

A M. K. Pearson appears at this spot in 1877.
