DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Burlin-Rawlings House c. 1870 is a two story four bay by one room two room frame house with an ell kitchen wing on Jacob Tome Highway south of West Nottingham. The house faces west with the gable running north/south.

The house rests on a fieldstone foundation and is sheathed with a horizontal weatherboard. The roof is covered with molded imitation tin shingle. A central brick stove stack rises out of the front block.

The west (main) elevation has three openings on the first floor and two 2/2 sash with plain surrounds. The central entrances are flanked by two 2/2 windows. The first floor is covered with a shed roof porch with tin shingle roof. The roof of the main house is extended with the eaves open.

The north and south gable ends have a single 2/2 sash window on each floor along with a 2/2 attic sash. The gable end above the plate is sheathed with fishscale shingle.

The kitchen wing extends eastward and was built in two sections. The original two story ell was one bay by one room and a later frame addition with block foundation. The later section is lighted by 6/6 sash. A two story shed roof porch is attached to the north side of the kitchen wing. The second story is enclosed.

The farmhouse is set on a small rise and the farm building complex is located on another knoll to the southwest. The main bank barn is surrounded by more modern dairy farm structures. The barn is frame and rests on a fieldstone foundation with an earthen ramp on the north side.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Burlin-Rawlings farm complex is arranged around two neighboring knolls with no particular formal association between farmhouse and farm structures. The farmhouse is a less typical two room plan frame house with two front doors from the third to fourth quarter of the 19th century. The farm structures are much more common forms.

D. Burlin owned this property in 1877.
