DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Krauss-Wyatt House c. 1830-1860 consists of two stuccoed brick sections probably built within 20 years of each other. The 1½ story two bay by one room sections was probably the first with a later two story two bay by one room brick gable end addition to the north. The house faces west with the main gable on a north/south axis.

The west elevation is covered partially by a single story shed roofed addition which is stuccoed on the south half and covered with aluminum on the north half. The 1½ story section has no second floor openings while the adjacent section has two second floor 6/6 sash windows. A plain corbelled cornice finishes the eaves of the 1½ story house while a corbelled cornice with a row of dentils decorates the two story eave. The first floor of the 1½ story section has been removed to enlarge the kitchen. The entrance is the northern part occupies the south of the two openings.

The north end is a plain stuccoed wall except for an exterior basement entry. An interior end stack rises out of the house with a plain barge-board protecting the eave. The east side is basically the same as the front with a fully stuccoed shed addition covering the first floor. A single pane sash window lights the second floor with a dentiled cornice above. The shorter 1½ sections is primarily covered by the shed addition. A plain corbelled cornice decorates the eave. The south end has an interior end chimney also with an adjacent entrance in the eastern opening.

The interiors of both sections have been fully remodeled.
