**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Sharpless-Jackson House c. 1858-1877 is a two story three bay by one room center hall stuccoed fieldstone house on Nesbitt Road and  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile east of Love Run Road. The house faces north with an east/west gable axis.

The main block with frame shed kitchen off back rests on a fieldstone foundation and is covered with a medium sloped slate roof with extended eaves and sloped soffits.

The north elevation consists of three evenly spaced bays with a central entrance and flanking 6/6 sash windows with beaded surrounds. The four panel door is heavily molded with arched top panels. A five light transom and three light sidelights with panel below frame the door. The reveals are also paneled. A shed porch covers the three bays and is supported by thin square posts with stick brackets.

Three second floor windows are the same as the first floor and aligned with the first floor openings.

The two gable ends are basically the same with two 6/6 sash on each floor and two 2/2 attic sash that flank the interior end brick stove stacks. A basement entrance on the west end permits exterior access to the cellar.

The south (back) side is partially covered by the single story frame shed kitchen. Three 6/6 sash light the second floor.

The interior was only partially surveyed. Four panel doors were framed by molded surrounds with bulls-eye corner blocks in the east parlor. The rest of the house was not seen.

The property did not include any farm structures or outbuildings.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Local fieldstone supplied the necessary materials to raise this traditional house type in the third quarter of the 19th century. The stone was undoubtedly subject to seepage so a coat of stucco was applied to weatherproof the structure. The house could date ~~etc~~ to the early 1850's since a G. W. Mendenhall was located here in 1858. By the publication of the Lake, Griffing, and Stevenson Atlas the owner had changed to W. M. Sharpless.
