**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The Tyson-~~Blanchard~~<sup>1860 -</sup> stone house c. 1870 is a two story three bay center hall single pile fieldstone house located back a long lane off Jacob Tome Highway and south of West Nottingham. The house faces west with the main gable on a north/south axis.

The main block rests on a fully excavated fieldstone foundation and is covered with a medium sloped composition shingle roof. A single story frame kitchen and front porch are attached to the south end and west side respectively.

The west (main) elevation is symmetrically arranged with a central entrance and flanking 2/2 sash windows with plain surrounds. A central four panel door allows entrance into the center hall. The shed porch is supported by square posts. The only other element of the main elevation is a plain boxed cornice.

The north gable end has two 2/2 sash on each floor and two four pane attic lights that flank the interior end brick stove stacks. The gable ends above the second floor are raised with frame and covered with weatherboard.

The south gable end is partially covered with the shed kitchen under the shed roof porch. The second and attic floors are the same as the north end. The east side has two 2/2 sash windows that occupy the outer bays. Three 2/2 sash light the second floor.

The interior woodwork dates from the third quarter of the 19th century. An enclosed central rises to the second floor. Four panel doors are framed by molded surrounds. There are no mantels in the house. Entrance to the basement is gained through a trap door below the main stair. The basement is divided into two rooms with an interior stone wall with supportive stone arches in the interior eastern corners.

The attic is entered by an enclosed stair. The attic is finished. There are no 19th century farm structures.
