Bohemia Hill is a two-and-one-half story dwelling with mansard roof which has been covered with stucco. It appears to be an earlier building than the period of the mansard roof. It is three bays long and two bays deep. A one-story porch is attached to the west facade and part of the south. The room on the north side of the center hall has elaborate Georgian carved detail (which seems almost out of place). The house is situated on a high hill overlooking the Bohemia and Elk Rivers.
