DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The J. J. Abrahams House or Quarters CC is a two-story frame house on a fieldstone foundation with a one-story porch which is located at the west end of Davis Road near the Port Deposit Reservoir on the grounds of the Susquehanna Job Corps Center (formerly Bainbridge Naval Training Center and Tome School for Boys) near Port Deposit, Maryland. The house is partially ruined by fire.

The house has a four-bay elevation facing southeast. The shed porch has chamfered posts and scroll sawn brackets. A central brick chimney projects from the roof, which is partially burned through. The roof is covered by composition material. The exterior covering is aluminum siding.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The house designated as Quarters CC by the Navy may have been built as early as 1840, although many alterations and additions have been made over a long period. This is possibly the J. J. Abrahams house shown on the 1877 Lake, Griffing and Stevenson Atlas of Cecil County. After its acquisition by the Tome School for Boys, the house was probably used as living quarters for school employees.




