With the Heckart House I (CE-1275), it formed a farm complex. This frame house has a stone foundation, but its original exterior has been covered with aluminum siding.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Quarters H or the Heckart House II is a two and one-half story frame building on a stone foundation located immediately east of Quarters G (Heckart House I, CE-1275) between Tome and Benson Roads on the grounds of the Susquehanna - Chesapeake Job Corps Center (formerly Bainbridge Naval Training Center) near Port Deposit, Maryland.

The house has a columned shed roofed entry porch on the south elevation, but the present main entry is on the east. The south elevation has five irregular bays with a center entry. The fenestration is six over six aluminum sash. The gable roof is composition material and a brick interior chimney projects from the north end of the roof. The stone foundation is uncoursed rubble and the exterior covering is aluminum siding.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

Quarters H or the Heckart House II is the oldest known building on the grounds of the former Bainbridge Naval Training Center. With the nearby Quarters G (Heckart House I, CE-1275), this house formed a farm complex and appeared on the 1877 Lake, Griffing and Stevenson Atlas of Cecil County. Both houses were renovated by the Navy for officers' quarters and are currently occupied by Job Corps Center employees.




