**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

The J. S. Everist House or Quarters W is a two-story frame house with a gable roof and one-story porch which is located on Fiske Road north of the amphitheater on the grounds of the former Bainbridge Naval Training Center near Port Deposit, Maryland.

The main elevation faces south and has five bays with a center entrance. A central gable peak breaks the roof cornice. The one-story porch has a shed roof and scroll sawn brackets. The porch is enclosed by screens. A central brick chimney projects through the roof. An ell and shed additions at the rear appear to be at least partially contemporary with the main section, but the present exterior covering of aluminum siding prevents visual determination of the building sequence. The roofing material is composition and most windows have six over six aluminum sash.




