DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Building 53 is a frame barn with a gable roof which is located immediately northeast of the sewage disposal plant on the grounds of the former Bainbridge Naval Training Center near Port Deposit, Maryland.

The barn has vertical siding painted red and a standing seam metal roof. The barn was built using the technique of wood pegs at beam joints.
