On the east side of the road at College Green stands a mid 18th century brick house which has subsequently been covered with stucco and plaster. There is a molded water table on three sides and it is three bays long and two storys high with "A" roof. There is a two bay, two story wing on the east of the main portion and the outline of a 1 1/2 story wing on the west gable. There are segmental arches above the basement windows and those on the ground floor of the south facade. In each gable are two four pane casement windows lighting the attic.
