NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC <i>No</i> <p>Near the intersection of Jackson Park and Belvidere Roads stands a house dating from the mid-nineteenth century. The front portion is three bays long and comprises a stair hall and parlor. It is two stories tall with steeply pitched roof and a one story porch above a high basement. The sash of this section is 6/9 and 6/6 on the first and second floors respectively. Behind the frame portion is a two story stone kitchen wing which is two bays wide and comprises only the kitchen. There is a wood lintel above the fireplace and remains of an exterior bake oven can be seen on the gable end. The latter stone section has 6/6 sash on first floor and 3/6 sash on second floor.</p>
