Near Octoraro stands a 2 & 1/2 story stone house which is three bays long, and one room deep, with a two-story wing to the south. The wing was clearly a one-story kitchen wing ^{which can} be traced between the stone and later frame part. There ^{is also} traces of a bake oven on the exterior south gable. ^{These} Above the windows and doors of the main portion of the house ^{are} stone segmental arches. The frames are nearly flush with the walls and are beaded and the sash have two over two panes. The building appears to be of the middle eighteenth century. Near the house once stood a mill which was operated by the waters of Octoraro Creek.
