Ellersly  
 Ellersly is a two and one half story masonry building in the Greek Revival style. The south facade is five bays long and there is a one story doric porch over three bays. The center door has a rectangular transom and sidelights. On the second floor is a three part window. There are three dormers on the south pitch of the "A" roof. In each gable are two chimneys with partial curtain wall between. The sash are 6/8 throughout. There are no windows on the gables which appear to be two rooms wide. six over six

The north facade is six bays long and the present owner says that it was built in two stages. The smaller windows on the west half may be an indication of the two building periods.

5. PHYSICAL CONDITION OF STRUCTURE Endangered No Interior poor Exterior poor

This house originally had an oyster shell lane a mile long, which led to the Old Post Road. It was owned by the Gale family at one time.
