This Rental House is located in Cecil County, within the Fair Hill N.R.M.A., at 118 Big Elk Chapel Road.

The House has a "T"-shaped plan, is two and one-half stories tall, and is three-bays long by two-bays wide. There are one-story additions on each side of the "T", both the east and west facades, that expands the living space considerably. The House rests on a fieldstone foundation, with uncut stones and no coursing. Upper stories are wood frame construction, with the exterior wall cladding material, white painted, horizontal clapboard. The front (north) facade has a cross gable roof, with the entire roof surface covered with standing seam tin. On each gable end there are interior brick chimneys, with a metal wood stove flue situated on the outside of the west facade. Windows and doors have decorated window trim, essentially the only decoration on the exterior. The attic front gable has a pointed arch window with 2/2 sash, while the lower stories have pedimented window trim with 2/2 sash.

Also on the property is a wood frame barn, set back from the road on a dirt surface driveway. The barn has vertical, unpainted, wood siding. It has a shed roofed addition to the side (east) facade, and a tin covered roof surface. Sliding barn doors face towards the driveway, and an attic window is located under the front gable.

Both the House and barn are in good condition.




