DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This brick house faces south, T-shaped, the main house is 3 stories, the wing running north 2 stories high.

Basically 5 bays by 2, the main house is altered to have two bay windows each beside the center-hall door. The wing has 3 bays by 1.

Windows upstairs have 1 light on 1, downstairs 4/4, in the main house; in the wing windows are 6/6.

The roof has a low pitch with the gable over the front door with an oval window centered. Casements of 2 lights each are in the end walls beside the flush chimneys.

The end on the front door is sketched below →





4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO <p>217 E. Main St is a five bay long brick building with pediment gable facade facing the street. It is two bays deep and has a long two story brick wing out the rear of the building. The brick is laid in all stretcher bond and the brick of the facade is smoother than the remainder of the structure. There are flat arches above the windows except the middle second floor window which consists of three parts and has segmental arch above. All second floor windows have 1/1 sash and louvered shutters.</p> <p>First floor facade consists of a central door having semicircular fanlight, like Essex Lodge near Earleville, flanked by pilasters which support the roof of the entrance porch, and two three-part bay windows. The roof of the porch connects the roof of the bay window. On each side of the steps to the porch is a squat squat balustrade and two square columns of the same design as the pilasters.</p> <p>eyebrow windows in the attic are visible on each side of the chimney on the east and west sides of the main structure.</p>
