

<p>220 East Main St. is a three story brick house of the 1850's and resembles in design and construction several of the buildings in this block of East Main St. It is three bays long and two bays deep with two story wing out the south side of the building. The brick is laid in all stretcher bond with very thin mortar joints. White paneled shutters flank the first floor windows and green louvered shutters flank the second story windows, both with 6/6 sash. The third floor windows have three pane casements. The cornice contains the gutter and has two boxes connected to the down spouts with the date 1853 and an American eagle. The roof is a low hipped one with a chimney in the east and west sides.</p> <p>A one story porch with grapevine design of cast iron with outer edge of same design hanging from the <i>pa</i> cornice of the porch is a typical treatment in this block of East Main Street.</p>		OPEN TO PUBLIC NO
