The Eggers House at Lombard was built in 1837 as indicated on the date stone in the west gable, with the initials CEB. It is a two story stone building, four bays long and two bays deep. The door occupied the second bay from the east side. The building has an "A" roof over the stucco-covered walls. There is a two story kitchen wing on the northwest side of the building. There are porches on each side of the kitchen wing and over the front entrance of no architectural merit. The entire interior has been remodeled in recent years. The present owner had an open stair install, in the same corner as the old enclosed stair, which is still there under the new stair.
