This frame clapboard building is now apartments for boat yard workers for the thriving yachting world of Frederick & Georgetown.

L shaped, 3 stories under a gambrel roof. The front section of 3 bays by 2 faces south, the roof ridge runs east-west. The long back wing, 3 bays widely spaced by 1, has a chimney near the middle of the building. 2 dormers on each side have a low peaked roof.



<p>To the east of the Granary stands a three story dwelling. It is an "L" shaped house with gambrel roof. The main door on the right side of the three bay front has a transom and side lights. The windows reach nearly to the floor of the front porch. All windows on the first and second floor have louvered shutters. The roof and the gable-end above the box cornice, which encircles the building, have fish scale shingles. There are two dormers on the roof. 

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
