

West Nottingham Church was built in 1880 and as many buildings of that period cannot be classified in any one style. The entire structure is built of granite with some decorative portions of sandstone. The south facade has an entrance on each side in a portion which is set back from the main facade. They have double doors and a pent hood above, supported by brackets and have a pierced design in the fascia. The center portion of the facade has two tiers of three windows, the upper tier having longer windows with semicircular arches, and finally a bulls eye louvered window with keystone trim. The slate "A" roof of the center portion of the facade has an overhang with bracket cornice. At the apex of the roof is an open bellfry with square cupola above surmounted by a decorative wrought iron cross.

The building has four large windows along its sides and the overhang to the roof has exposed rafters.

Surrounding the Church is a grave yard and adjoining the Church, by a more recent hyphen, is the chapel which was built in 1880.




