The southwest gable has four gothic windows with stained glass. Above the windows the siding changes from clapboard to decorative cut shingles. In the gable is a rose window. To the south is a bell tower with steeple and opposite it is a gabled entrance which matches that beneath the tower. It is three bays deep on each side beyond the entrance bay. There are buttresses at each corner.</p>


