Once a side-hall house, 3 bays by 2, the front windows have been altered to make a picture window on the street, and the partitions are much altered.

STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANCE

The Bull's Head Tavern stood on this site, and probably some of its timbers form the frame of the present dwelling.

The railroad - first known as the Philadelphia Baltimore & Washington Railroad, then the Pennsylvania R.R. and now Penn Central - ran on a curved line bringing it in to serve the population of Elkton. A demand for increased speed eliminated both the curve and the frequency of stops in this area.

This small frame house, clapboard ^{with} ^{aluminum} siding, is T shaped in plan, 2 stories high 3 bays by 0 in the main section.

Facied west, the A frame roof ridgepole runs north-south. Window styles vary from 6/6, 6/1 and 1/1, while a new front picture window is a solid sash. There is a large chimney inside the south end wall, a smaller one at the east end of the wing.

The wing ~~part~~ has wide flush plank siding over a heavy log frame.

There is said to be a ditch over still in the basement.

Once a stopping-off point for early travelers when the rail line came into Elkton a few feet away.




