

<p>One of the finest buildings in Fredricktown is a two story frame house of beaded clapboard. It has a stone foundation. It is three bays wide and two bays deep and has a steeply pitched "A" roof. The front and back doors have six raised panels and are both surmounted by a transom with diamond panes. The front door, located in the center of the facade, is flanked by two 9 over 6 windows. On the second floor there are three windows, 6 over 6. All windows and doors are trimmed with ovolo and bead moldings. There are louvered shutters throughout. On each gable-end in the attic there are two four-pane square casement windows. Both chimneys are built within the house and have a simple two brick projected cap. On the east end of the house there was a kitchen wing as there is now an exterior fireplace backed up to the one within the house. It is flanked by two doors. The interior is divided into a great room. To the east of this, there is a stair hall and a smaller room. The rooms have period window trim and chair rail and mantels.</p>


