This Rental House at the Finley Compound is located in Cecil County, within the Fair Hill N.R.M.A., and off of the access road that crosses the Management Area. It is to the west of Big Elk Creek, to the east of Maryland route 213, to the south of the Mason-Dixon line, and to the north of Maryland route 273. The Finley Compound is near the Big Elk Creek Covered Bridge.

This House is covered from the foundation to the eaves with vinyl siding that obscures it's original construction material, which most likely is frame construction. It is built into the hillside with a stone retaining wall creating outside access to multiple levels of the house. In addition there is a frame screened in porch on the side (south) facade. The roof is covered with composition shingles, with a large central stone chimney. Storm windows cover the 6/6 sash windows. This house was owned by the DuPont family and may have undergone major renovations at the same time the main Finley House was remodeled, during the 1930's.

This Rental House at the Finley Compound is in excellent condition.
