

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This small brick church has a steep slate roof with wide eaves and a low belfry under a painted slate roof over the crossing of the nave and transept.

A modified cross in plan, the gable end to the street facing north, arms of the cross are wide with three windows, arched, under a rose window in the gable above, on the east and west sides of the building.
