Addendum

The Kennel Compound is located in Cecil County, within the Fair Hill N.R.M.A., and on the dirt access road that crosses the Management Area. It is to the east of MD route 213, west of Gallaher Road, south of MD route 273, and north of Big Elk Chapel Road. The easiest way to get to the dirt access road is by entering at the Fair Hill Race Track, MD route 273 entrances, and then heading south. Two dog kennels and a farmhouse are the three structures included within the Kennel Compound.

The farmhouse has not deteriorated since the last Historic Sites Survey was completed in 1979. It is still a rental property and is kept in good condition. A covering of asbestos shingles over the entire exterior walls has been added to both the 1940's frame additions and the historic stone house that are obscured beneath all the changes.

The two dog kennels are not historic. Both are large one-story structures, but one is constructed of wood frame and the other is concrete block construction. A fenced in yard surrounds the wood frame kennel. These structures are in excellent condition and are used for raising beagles.



DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

Originally a very small two storey stone house, one room over another, a gable roof running north-south, principal entrance on the east elevation. Frame additions have been made on the south (two storey) and west (one storey) and a large screened-in porch with sun deck above were added to the east facade. There is an early mantle piece on the fireplace of the first storey, in the old portion, on a raised hearth, reaching almost to the ceiling.
