This frame mill, clapboard covered, stands 2 1/2 stories on a stone foundation exposed on 3 sides. Façade ~~is~~ south, 4 widely spaced bays by 3, the low-angled pitched roof/ridgeline runs east-west. Windows have 6 lights on 6.

The mill race has filled, the dam destroyed, ~~the mill~~, and the mill unused for decades.




