DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (if known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This fine old stone house is two stories high, 5 bays by 2 on the south side, 3 bays on the north or facing the road. It was once center-hall in plan.

Almost square, the building has a pitched roof of tin, with trim eaves and no cornice. Chimneys rise inside the end walls, ^{out} ~~to~~ the peak on the west, two on either side of the roof to the east.

Window openings have brick lintels, stone sills, while windows downstairs are 9 over 6, upstairs 6 over 6. Frames are pegged, as is rafter construction seen in the attic and cellar.
