

<p>Across the street from the federal frame house stands a 2 1/2 story frame clapboard residence with mansard roof. The foundation is constructed of brick and is nearly a full story high at the south end of the house. The facade, on the north, is five bays wide. The door is in the center and is trimmed with plain pilasters with a transom above. All sashes have only one pane of glass. The dormers in the slate fish scale roof are trimmed with brackets. On the west of the house is a two story bay window covered with fish scale shingles. Beyond the bay, off the "L", is a two story porch. 
