4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is a large rambling stone house of the Federal period preserved in excellent condition. The main house is five bays wide and two deep. All the windows are 6/6 sashes and there is a central door. The house has corner quoins of very large blocks of stone which is very smooth. It has a gently pitched A-roof and there are two hooded dormers on the roof. The house is set on a high basement and there are large basement windows with horizontal bars. There is a chimney enclosed within each end wall of the house. There is a large wing projecting off the rear of the house which is only about two years later in date than the main house. It is four bays wide and two deep. It has, like the main house, two round-hooded dormers on the roof. This is a very elegant well-proportioned house.

The interior is simply panelled and has nicely carved Federal mantels. The kitchen fireplace is very large and has a huge log for a lintel. All the doors on the house have unusual iron spoon-locks on the doors.

There is a stone smokehouse which dates from the 18th century and went with an older house which was once on this site. There are ruins of a mill on a stream on the property. There are also ruins of stone slave buildings. This is a very well-maintained and attractive property with many historic associations.
