DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (If known) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This is a small two storey stone farm house. The exterior has been covered with stucco and painted white. The building was once two separate homes the western end of the structure was built first and the eastern section added shortly after. The older section consists of one room up and one room down. There is a large walking fireplace nearly taking up the entire ^{eastern} ~~western~~ wall of this side of the house. To the left of the fireplace was a little staircase to the second floor and to the right an entrance has been made to the newer section. The window trim in this portion of the house is very plain and has been pegged together. The window sash is 2/2 and is not the original, but is still old. There is a door on both the front and rear of the western section of the house. The eastern side of the house has architrave woodwork and a fine pine floor, much of the woodwork ~~are~~ is original. Very nice wooden mantel. Door to outside on south wall has eight panels. Fireplace on second floor with wooden mantel. Roof work is pegged. Originally a porch extended across the front of the building. Has date 1774 on chimney.
