**DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE**

This farmhouse is a two storey frame building with white clapboard siding. It has two inside end chimneys at the north and south ends of the building. They are constructed of stone and have been covered with stucco. The window sash is 6/6 with the only exception being two small windows in the attic storey in the north end of the house. The windows have green board and batten shutters which are fairly new. The foundation is uncoursed rubble. The southern end of the house has a tile (gray) covering. There are four fireplaces in the house.

There are two major additions to the house. One is along the southern wall of the building and has a shed roof. The other is a screened-in porch on the northern end of the house.
