4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC NO

This is an interesting house which may be older than it appears at first glance. It appears that there were originally many good details on the house now obscured by remodelings and alterations. The house is three bays wide and one room deep. It has a central door. All the windows are Victorian 2/2 sashes and have wooden lintels and sills. From evidence in the brickwork, these windows were originally smaller and had flat brick arches. The arches were mostly destroyed when the new and larger 2/2 sashes were installed. There is a water-table of sloping brick along the front of the house. There is a four string belt-course along the front of the house. It has a top row of sloping brick, then a plain row, and then two rows of slightly recessed brick. There is a large round-arched opening at the basement level on one end; this opening is now bricked up. At each gable end of the house there are five horizontal bands of glazed brick.

This small house has many interesting 18th century details and was one of the few houses found in Cecil County to employ patterned brick. It is in need of repairs.
