

The Hart/Crouch House is a 2-story, hipped pyramidal roofed stucco residence of the 1920s bungalow style. It has one hipped dormer with a ribbon window, a 1-story shed addition and a 3-bay porch in front. Based on modern renovations and the lack of distinct characteristics of a type, period or method of construction, this structure would not be eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places.

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This dwelling is a two story frame building three bays by one. The exterior is covered with clapboard. Beneath the house is a full basement with stone walls. The facade of the home has a one story three bay long porch with chamfered posts supporting the roof. The front door is paneled and dates from the Victorian period.

To the rear of this original section is a wing one and a half stories in height. There is an inside end chimney in the western end and the roof has shed dormers. The south side of the wing has a porch. The window sash throughout is 6/6 with plain trim. The roof is asphalt and gable in both.

There is a small building which sits to the rear of the dwelling that was used as a garage.
