This is a two-and-a-half story frame dwelling three by two with a two-story rear wing. It is of Victorian period and has a central peaked dormer. At each gable end is a brick inside end chimney. The roof has asphalt shingles and the exterior surface has been covered with aluminum siding. All of the original sash has been removed. A one-story porch with period brackets is in good condition.
