4. NOTABLE FEATURES, HISTORICAL SIGNIFICANCE AND DESCRIPTION OPEN TO PUBLIC **NO**

The remodelings carried out to this house make it an especially interesting one. It is a monument to the changes in architectural taste from the eighteenth to the nineteenth century. Its basic form is a five bay long, one room deep, brick Georgian house of the late eighteenth century. The first story windows are 6/9, while those on the second story are 6/6. There are flat brick arches over all the windows. The central door has a pediment and pilasters and a lunette with radiating muntins. There is a chimney built into each end wall of the house. Added to this house in the Greek Revival mode was a one story porch across the central three bays of the front. This porch is supported by four heavy Ionic columns. And then, in Victorian times, in a Gothic style, a large central gable and a smaller dormer on either side were added to the front roof. These, along with the cornice, are decorated with cut Victorian woodwork. To the right of the main house, and probably added sometime in the nineteenth century is a lower three bay wide 2-1/2 story brick addition.

This house is notable for its architectural heritage and commingling of styles. It is very attractive in appearance and is well kept-up. The grounds contain many large gingko and linden trees.




