DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Charles Owens House is a Victorian style frame building of simple design. It is two and a half storys in height with chimneys in the north and south gable. On the rear is a two story wing with an inside end chimney in the gable end. The framework is covered with clapboard. In the central bay of the uppermost floor is a peaked dormer. with lancet style windows. The facade has a one story porch supported by columns while the south side of the building has a similar porch, but with Victorian like brackets and posts. The sash is two over two. The house rests on a stone foundation and has a cellar.
