DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Winfield Mahoney Farmhouse is an L-shaped frame building. The front section is three bays long by two deep, while the rear wing is two bays by two. The structure once had clapboard siding but aluminum has been placed over the original. This farmhouse is two stories in height with inside end chimneys in each gable wall made of brick. The house has a cellar and a very nicely laid stone foundation. On the western wall of the wing is a one-story Victorian porch. There is no cornice and the roof has wooden shingles.

There is a medium-sized fram barn mortice and tenon construction with siding. A wind mill is located next to the barn. Among the other out-buildings is a one-story frame structure with board-and-batten siding with strap hinges on the door.

The window sash on the house is 2/2 and the barn has 6/6 in the foundation. The rear wing could be older than the front section.
