The Ulmer Victorian House is a two-story structure three bays by three with a gable roof. There is an inside end chimney in each gable wall. There is also a small stove chimney in the northeast corner of the structure. The exterior of this building is covered with aluminum siding as is the roof. Originally, there was a clapboard siding and wooden shingles on the roof. The facade has a door (double) with arched panels. It also has a transom. The window sash is 6/6. A one-story porch runs the entire three bays of the facade. This house has a stone foundation and cellar.
